Black Snake Productions will once again be entertaining audiences at the Mildura Field Days. Check out the What's On for Show times.















Over 30 years after its initial launch in 1987 Crime Stoppers Australia is going strong as an independent not-for-profit registered charity representing the collective eight Crime Stopper organisations operating in every state and territory of Australia.

The organisation is committed to achieving a safe, empowered and engaged community working hard to provide people with an opportunity to share information about unsolved crimes and suspicious activity.

They work closely with the police, media and the community to help solve, reduce and prevent crime by collecting information and passing on

those details to police and other law enforcement agencies to help keep all of our communities and families safe.

Crime Stoppers Victoria was the pioneering organisation in Australia when the program was started by Victoria Police. It was established following a Churchill Fellowship report by Geoff Wilkinson, the then director of media for Victoria Police. He had painstakingly reviewed existing programs in America and Britain for enlisting the community to assist in helping to solve crimes. He recommended that Victoria Police implement a program involving the police, media and the public working together.

Since its inception, up until June 2022, they have received over 1.33 million tips from the community, resulting in over 27,600 arrests and the recovery of more than \$406 million worth of drugs, property and cash.

Operating on the concept of anonymously reporting crime or suspected crime the communitybased initiative encourages members of the public to provide information on unsolved crimes, wanted people and people they know are involved in criminal activity.





SecureEnergy has been contracted by Transgrid to build EnergyConnect, a new 700km transmission line extending from Wagga Wagga NSW to the South Australian border. This backbone infrastructure will connect customers with more renewable energy enabling a further 4950MW of generation capacity, save NSW customers \$180 million a year and create 1,500 new construction jobs



The \$1.8 billion EnergyConnect project will enable the sharing of electricity between NSW, South Australia, and Victoria for the first time, integrate renewable energy into the grid, and help Australia achieve its emissions reduction targets.

The project includes:

- The construction of two new 330kV transmission lines and one new 500kV transmission line
- A rebuild of an existing 220kV transmission line at Red Cliffs, Victoria.
- An expansion and upgrade of the existing Buronga substation

- A new substation known as Dinawan, located between Jerilderie and Coleambally.
- An expansion of the existing Wagga Wagga substation.

EnergyConnect, once completed, will be Australia's largest interconnector in the Australian National Electricity Market (NEM).

The project is contributing \$4 billion in net economic benefits, providing a major economic injection in local communities along the project alignment such as Mildura and Wentworth. SecureEnergy has so far invested more than \$30 million with more than 75 local businesses who are supplying goods and services to the project. Spending in local communities, awarding local procurement packages and buying locally is a key priority.
