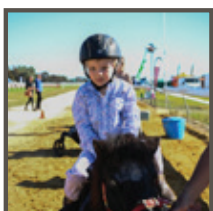

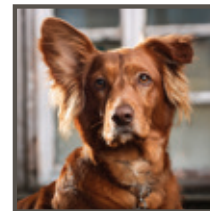

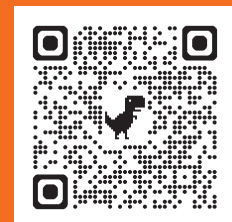

The question has been asked as to why!

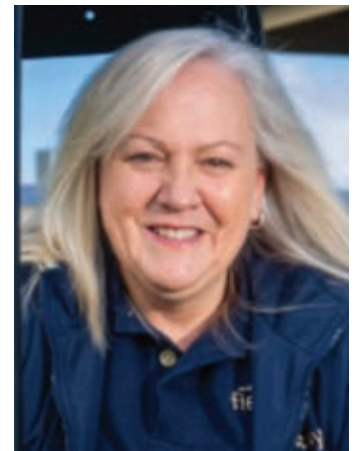
Why do we work hard to hold the annual event?

"Whether chosen or forced upon us, adversity shows us what we're truly capable of."

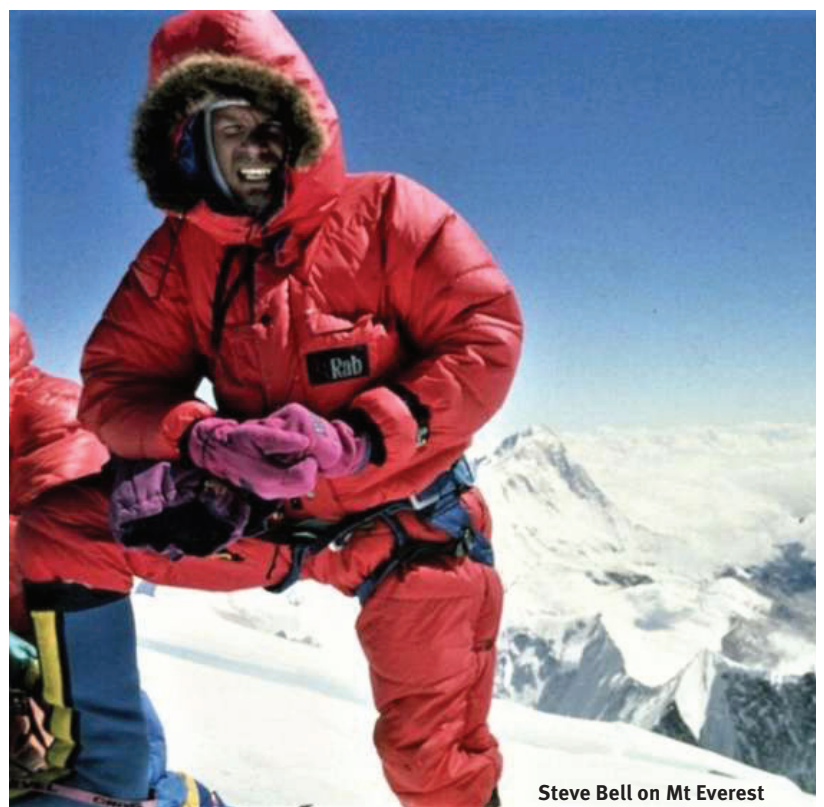
There will be an opportunity for a Q & A session at the end of Steve's presentation offering a chance for personal connection with him.
